

For those who do not know, the Portion name comes from the first word or words of the portion in Torah. This week the Torah Portion name is Balak and is translated as “Balak.”

Shabbat Message:

Your Kingdom an Everlasting Kingdom, and Your Dominion throughout all generations. The LORD upholds all that fall, and raises up all bowed down. The eyes of all wait upon You; and You give them their meat in due season. You open Your hand, and satisfies the desire of every living thing. The LORD righteous in all His Ways, and Holy in all His Works. The LORD is near to all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him in truth. He will fulfill the desire of them that fear Him: He also will hear their cry, and will save them. The LORD preserves all them that love Him: but all the wicked will He destroy. My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless His Holy Name for ever and ever. (Ps. 145)

To Him which led His people through the wilderness: for His Mercy for ever: To Him which smote great kings: for His Mercy for ever: and slew famous kings: for His Mercy for ever: Sihon king of the Amorites: for His Mercy for ever: and Og the king of Bashan: for His Mercy for ever: and gave their land for an heritage: for His Mercy for ever: an heritage to Israel His servant: for His Mercy for ever. Who remembered us in our low estate: for His Mercy for ever: and has redeemed us from our enemies: for His Mercy for ever. Who gives food to all flesh: for His Mercy for ever. O give thanks unto the God of Heaven: for His Mercy for ever. (Ps. 136)
